



COVID Procedures - Family Camp

Updated January 2022

- Camp Stevens strongly recommends that everyone attending be fully vaccinated and get a negative COVID test prior to the event (within 3 days if a PCR test or 24 hours if a rapid test).
- Program and activities will occur outdoors except in extreme weather. We recommend that guests bring warm and waterproof clothing and shoes in preparation for inclement weather.
- Masks are not required in your private room, but are required regardless of vaccination status in all shared indoor spaces, such as the dining hall, dining hall bathrooms, and lodge common rooms. We reserve the right to refuse service to any guest not willing to comply.
- Guests should bring their own surgical, N95 type, or multi-layer cloth masks (at least 1 per person per day plus a few extra). Please no neck gaiters, single layer cloth masks, or bandanas.
- Guests will have the choice to sit indoors or outdoors for meals, weather permitting. Guests must wear masks inside the dining hall unless they are sitting down and eating.
- Persons who have been in close contact with confirmed or suspected Coronavirus in the last 7 days and persons showing symptoms of communicable illness are not permitted at Camp Stevens. If a guest starts showing symptoms while on site, they will be asked to leave.
- Please notify camp if you or anyone in your group tests positive for COVID within 7 days following camp.
- All Camp Stevens staff are fully vaccinated and are tested weekly.
