



Camp Stevens is currently open to overnight guests Friday-Sunday weekly. Lodging is priced by the weekend and meals are included in the additional per person rate.

Each lodging option has, at a minimum, a private indoor sleeping area, restroom, shower, coffee maker, and upon request, a mini-fridge for your household. Check-in is after 4 pm on Fridays and check-out is before 12 pm on Sundays. Meals are served Saturday Breakfast through Sunday Breakfast. Overnight guests at Camp Stevens have access to outdoor seating areas, all hiking trails, lawn, basketball and volleyball courts (with own sports equipment), outdoor chapel, and treehouse. The pool and some activities will be available (weather and staffing permitted). Households must maintain social distancing from other households and camp staff. Masks must be available and on your person at all times, and be worn when unable to social distance (including passing on trails).

Bergstrom Lodge Room

Each room in the Bergstrom Lodge has a double bed and a twin-sized bed. Some of the rooms have an additional twin-size trundle. Linens are provided, and each room has a private bathroom, air conditioning, and coffee maker. Mini-fridge available upon request.

Rates: \$250 weekend rate for a room *plus* an additional per-person charge of \$60/adult and \$40/child (2-11 years old); Under 2 are free.

Bergstrom Lodge Suite

A suite in the Bergstrom Lodge includes a room with a double bed and a twin-sized bed. Some of the rooms have an additional twin-size trundle. Linens are provided, and each room has a private bathroom and air conditioning. The Suite rate also includes private access to a large lounge with sofas, mini-fridge, coffee and tea, fireplace, piano, and library space.

Rates: \$500 weekend rate for a suite *plus* an additional per-person charge of \$60/adult and \$40/child (2-11 years old); Under 2 are free.

Lax Sadler Lodge Room

A room in the Lax Sadler lodge consists of 2 living spaces connected by an indoor door. Each room has a total of 8 twin-sized beds (four lower bunks and four upper bunks) as well as a sofa, table, coffee maker, and two private bathrooms. Mini-fridge available upon request. Linens are not provided.

Rates: \$250 weekend rate for a room *plus* an additional per-person charge of \$60/adult and \$40/child (2-11 years old); Under 2 are free.

Lax Sadler Lodge Suite

A suite in the Lax Sadler Lodge includes two living spaces with 8 twin-sized beds (5 lower bunks and 3 upper bunks) and 3 private bathrooms. Linens are not provided. The Suite rate also includes private access to a large lounge with sofas, coffee and tea, a fireplace, and a piano. Mini-fridge available upon request.

Rates: \$500 weekend rate for a suite *plus* an additional per-person charge of \$60/adult and \$40/child (2-11 years old); Under 2 are free.



Wolterstorff Lodge

The Wolterstorff Lodge cannot be divided into private rooms so it can only be rented as a whole lodge. It has 24 beds total in 4 rooms. Each room sleeps 6 with four lower bunks and two upper bunks. There are two large bathrooms with multiple stalls located within the lodge and a large lounge with sofas, a mini-fridge, coffee & tea, a piano, as well as an outdoor deck that overlooks the orchard. Linens are not provided.

Rates: \$500 weekend rate for the lodge *plus* an additional per-person charge of \$60/adult and \$40/child (2-11 years old); Under 2 are free.

Phoenix Hill

Phoenix Hill has open air shelters with 8 cots. The shelters have no heat, running water, or electricity, but there is a nearby shower house with private flush toilets and warm showers for each family. Linens are not provided, coffee machines are not available at Phoenix Hill but guests may bring their own camping-style coffee setups or get coffee at breakfast.

Rates: \$100 weekend rate a cabin *plus* an additional per-person charge of \$60/adult and \$40/child (2-11 years old); Under 2 are free.

Lower Meadow Campsite

This campsite is located away from main camp and is available for tent camping. It has access to a composting toilet, a large table and a campfire ring. No showers are available, coffee machines are not available at the campsite but guests may bring their own camping-style coffee setups or get coffee at breakfast. Camping equipment is not included.

Rates: \$100 weekend rate *plus* an additional per-person charge of \$60/adult and \$40/child (2-11 years old); Under 2 are free.
