This outline can help start your creative process with recording and writing:

- Introduce yourself however you'd like, camp nickname, pronouns, etc.
- Years participated as a camper, counselor, staff, board, etc.
- Tell us a story
- Share one memory of camp with all the beautiful details you can remember.

 - "Dusty, rocky night's sleep at The Pit."
 - "Cool breeze after a long hike to Upper Meadow"

 - "Best meal of my life after hiking 15 miles in the Sierras"
 - "Beautiful sunset in Baja while Kayak on Baja de Los Angeles"
