

Transportation Information

Camp Stevens is 165 miles from Los Angeles and 60 miles from San Diego. The bus is provided at cost and gives campers an opportunity to make friends before arriving at camp.

You can take the bus round-trip or one-way. The Los Angeles-area bus costs \$50 roundtrip or \$25 each way. The San Diego bus costs \$30 roundtrip or \$15 each way. Luggage space is minimal so we must limit you to 1 sleeping bag/pillow and 1 duffel bag

PROCEDURES

BUS COUNSELORS: Camp Stevens provides a bus counselor for supervision. As campers arrive, the driver and bus counselor will each check-in campers. They will wait an additional 5 minutes for late arrivals. If a particular route has less than 12 campers, the camp van may be brought instead. The bus counselor/van driver is responsible for the safety and well-being of the campers. It is imperative that campers listen to the bus counselor/van driver for safety procedures and guidelines. These include wearing seatbelts when provided, obeying the instructions of the counselor/driver, and keeping the noise down to a reasonable level.

MEDICATION: Medication should be packed in a daypack or given to the bus counselor.

CAMPERS WILL NOT EXIT THE BUS ENROUTE: To minimize the risk of a camper getting lost, campers will not be allowed to leave the bus except in case of an emergency. Parents should provide lunch or snacks for their child's trip to camp. Snacks will be provided on the return trip.

CAMPER RELEASE: On the return trip, campers will only be released to their parents/guardians or emergency contacts. Please contact us in writing if you need to add someone to the pick-up list.

LATE PICK-UP: If you think you will be late, please call the emergency contact below. If a family does not arrive on time the bus will depart 5 minutes after the designated drop-off time with the camper aboard. No camper will be left unattended. The last stop is Burbank: The bus will remain there until a parent arrives or other arrangements are made.
